



COMPETITION HEAT POLICY

When the Bureau of Meteorology's 'Weather App' at 12.00 pm (midday) on a Thursday, forecasts that on the following Saturday the temperature for Bendigo City will be 38 deg or more, then hit off will be between 7.30 and 8.30 am for that Saturday's competition

When the Bureau of Meteorology's 'Weather App' at 12.00 pm (midday) on a Monday forecasts that on the following Wednesday the temperature for Bendigo City will be 38 deg or more, then hit off will be between 7.30 and 8.30 am for that Wednesday's competition.

When the Bureau of Meteorology's 'Weather App' at 12.00 pm (midday) on a Tuesday, forecasts that on the following Thursday the temperature for Bendigo City will be 38 deg or more, the Twilight Competition cannot commence unless the BOM Weather App temperature at hit off time, is below 38 deg. (Hit off time is from 5.30 to 6pm)

Members are also reminded that on these hot days you are to ensure that you carry plenty of water, wear sunscreen and a hat and where possible, try to stick to shaded areas.

Any player who does play the course on extreme heat days, does so at their own risk

(For the health & safety of players taking part in Special events, charity days, course hire along with green fee players, BPGC follows the Golf Australia's Hot Weather Guidelines.)
