

## **Open letter to Belvoir Park Members.**

Re: Reciprocal Rights – Axedale Golf Club

The Committee, at the meeting held on the 16<sup>th</sup> December 2020, has made the decision to terminate the “Reciprocal Rights Agreement” with the Axedale Golf Club. This action has been taken after due consideration of the Agreement, the Rules and By-Laws of Belvoir Park Golf Club and in the best interest of our Members.

It was determined that, the Mid-Week Local Reciprocal Agreement, welcomes all local district club members to join in our weekday competitions and hence allowing our members to play on and enjoy the other courses in the district, thus partially superseding the above mentioned Agreement.

Other considerations were:

- The timing differences of the agreeing two club’s financial years, member categories, fees and means of identification making it difficult to track those members who were financial to each club and the reporting of the same between the two entities.
- The lack of interest in the Beldale Cup competition from the members of both clubs and the probability that this competition will not be revived.
- Axedale’s fairway rejuvenation program has commenced and will continue over the next five (5) years. The continued existence of the agreement would be an overwhelming advantage to the Axedale Golf Club and influences the Axedale members to take full advantage of a reciprocal rights with Belvoir Park and to use our course as an excellent option whilst there are major interruptions to their home course.
- Both Axedale and Belvoir Park Golf Clubs have enjoyed excellent growth in membership over the past year making it difficult to enter additional visiting players into the allotted time slots of the field and we have already been notified by Axedale that there are no times available for Belvoir members in Axedale’s upcoming fund raising event.

Taking all of the above into account the effective date of agreement termination is deemed to be:
